YARRAMBAT JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB PROFIT & LOSS [CASH] STATEMENT October 2012 TO September 2013

I am pleased to present the 2012/13 Profit & Loss Statement for the Yarrambat Junior Football Club.

Throughout the year Club facilities and equipment were improved, early registered players were provided with free tracksuit pants and we were able to attain a small profit. This was all achieved with no increase to our registration fee.

Whilst overall our combined sponsorship, registration fees and merchandise sales remained steady, our canteen revenue, grants and donations were down resulting in reduced revenue to the Club.

On the expenses side, the club re-stocked football kits, bought new stretchers and purchased a significant amount of club merchandise, resulting in increased expenditure.

To be able to achieve a small profit whilst undertaking this level of expenditure is a credit to the hard work of the Committee, the Club's numerous volunteers and the support from all our YJFC families through attendance at Club functions. To this end, once again the successful Sharkwiz Trivia night was a major fundraiser (approx. \$13,500). Thanks go to all our members.

Of course the great support we receive from our Club Sponsors (in excess of \$20k) very much helps us provide and maintain such a great club for our kids. We thank you very much and look forward to your continued support.


It goes without saying that such a successful year doesn't just happen by chance and I would like to thank the club, committee and all volunteers for their support of our youngsters as they start their footballing journey.

To all the parents thank you for your support it's been fantastic.


